The Randolph Board of Health strives to reduce the generation of solid waste and toxicity in the waste stream by promoting recycling and purchasing of recyclable-content materials, educating residents, schools and businesses about the economic benefits of recycling and composting, and maintaining a clean environmentally conscious Town.

We seek grants and co-operative relationships with state and federal agencies, to help achieve these goals.

The Recycling Coordinator maintains liaison with the current trash contractor and responds to questions from residents and businesses concerning recycling and trash collection. Additional responsibilities include, but are not limited to, producing educational materials about recycling, trash, composting, hazardous waste and other environmental issues. Timely notifications and press releases are sent to the media and Randolph Community TV.

We plan and promote an annual hazardous waste collection day as well as a town-wide cleanup day.

We maintain specific areas for collections of biohazardous materials and electronic waste.

We maintain cardboard, paper, and clothing collection areas in several locations.
